Cranberry-Apple Dessert

1/3 cup butter or margarine
 2 ½ cups original Bisquick mix
 1 cup sugar
 1 ½ cups milk
 1 cup whole berry cranberry sauce
 1 cup chunky applesauce
 1 cup apple, thinly sliced
 Whipped Cream



Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In 13x9 pan, melt butter in oven.
 In medium bowl, stir Bisquick mix, sugar and milk until smooth.
 Pour batter evenly over butter in pan. In small bowl, mix
 cranberry sauce and applesauce; spoon evenly over batter.
 Place apple slices on sauce mixture. Bake 50 to 60 minutes or
 until golden brown. Serve warm with whipped cream.
