Leah's ala Carte

SWEET Brownie



- 1 cup butter, melted
- 2 cups white sugar
- ½ cup cocoa powder
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 4 eggs
- 1 1/2 cups flour
- ½ teaspoon baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease 9x13-inch pan. Combine the melted butter, sugar, cocoa powder, vanilla, eggs, flour, baking powder, and salt. Spread the batter into the prepared pan. Decorate with walnut halves. Bake in preheated oven for 20 to 30 minutes or until toothpick inserted in the center comes out with crumbs, not wet. Cool on wire rack.
